none of us knows when our time is up. 2018 is here; let us devote our

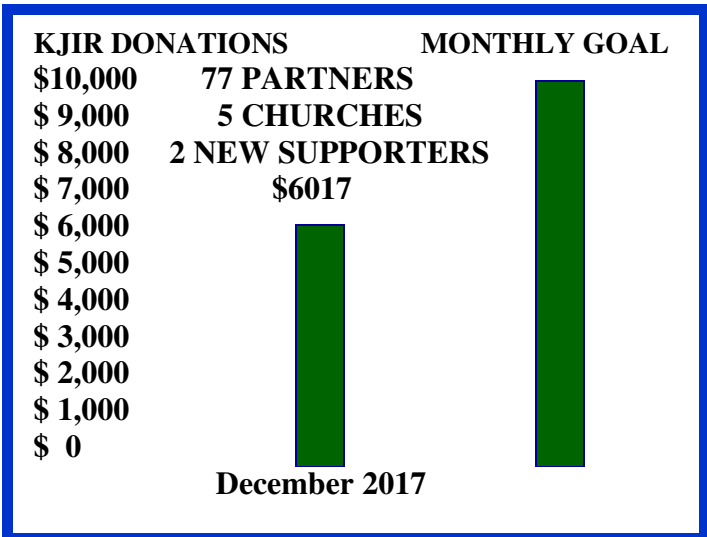
