Unless you like winter here's something good to think about. The Old Farmers Almanac reports that Thursday March 19th is the first day of Spring. Living in the midwest we all know that the cold days of winter will eventually give way to warmer weather. It's good to think on the good things, as the scripture says, **Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. (Philippians 4:8)** Of course, when Paul wrote these words to the Philippians he wasn't talking about the weather; he was referring to the truth and command of THE GOSPEL. He continued with, **Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace**

shall be with you. (Philippians 4:9) The most important word to note in verse 9 is "DO"! Do what the WORD OF GOD commands, **and the God of peace shall be with you.** In the Old Testament we read, **Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. Stay away from GOD and watch the news continually or dwell on what you don't have instead of what you do have, the end result is misery. I'm not saying to bury your head in the sand and ignore life's problems; we live in a fallen world

and are confronted with hardships everyday, which is why it's so important to have a mind full of GOD. JESUS said, **These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. (John 16:33)** In JESUS there is PEACE. HE is **THE PRINCE OF PEACE!** Having a relationship with JESUS is the greatest blessing given! **And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. 

