When Noah, his family, and all the animals vacated the Ark. GOD made a covenant with Noah. In that covenant we read. While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease. (Genesis 8:22) Here in the Midwest we get to experience all of that. Right now, we are entering into that harvesttime. The word harvest has a noun meaning and a verb meaning. Harvest as a noun means: the process or period of gathering in crops, it also means the product or result of an action. The action occurred during seedtime. The seed was planted with the expectation of a harvest. The verb side of harvest means: to gather (a crop) as a harvest, to collect or obtain (a resource) for future use. To use both meanings in one sentence we can say, "The harvest is here and it's time to harvest it". All throughout time GOD has used the illustration of the seed sown and the crop harvested. In

the covenant HE made after the flood GOD set that in place. Seedtime and harvesttime is work and requires workers, ask any farmer. You and I are the workers, but it is GOD who brings forth the increase (the harvest). Paul explained this to the Corinthians this way. I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. So then neither is he that planteth anything, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour. For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. (1 Corinthians 3:6-9) It's all of us working together with GOD that brings forth the harvest. Somebody in CHRIST planted the WORD OF GOD (seed) in somebody's heart. Somebody else in CHRIST came along and watered the seed. Then GOD by HIS GRACE caused that seed to grow. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to

do of his good pleasure. (Philippians 2:13) Then comes the harvest, A SOUL BIRTHED INTO THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN! That soul becomes another co-labourer with GOD. The more the harvest, the more the seed there is to plant for more harvest. We see this in Creation. And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. And the earth brought forth grass, and herb vielding seed after his kind, and the tree vielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good. (Genesis 1:11-12) Simply put, plant corn and you get corn, plant wheat and you get wheat. Plant the WORD OF GOD and you get CHRISTIANS. With the GRACE of GOD, CHRISTIANS are to produce more CHRISTIANS! The fruit
