Are you a Martha or a Mary? As we move into this time of the year there is a very important lesson for all of us to learn from the account of Martha and Marv found in Luke 10:38-42. Obviously, these sisters were followers of Our LORD JESUS, for Martha had welcomed HIM into their home and then set about to honor HIM through hospitality and fulfilling the expected role of a woman in that society. Hospitality was highly valued and the role of the women of the house was to make the guest welcome with the serving of food and drink. This was the tradition which in and of itself is very noteworthy and quite necessary at times. We are called to be hospitable especially to the household of GOD (Romans 12:13 & Galatians 6:10). But let's go back to that word "tradition". Defined tradition means: an inherited, established, or customary pattern of thought, action, or behavior. I believe

JESUS was always totally aware of HIS surroundings. Scripture says Mary was at HIS feet listening to HIS WORDS. JESUS knew Martha was doing all the work and never said anything to Mary about helping her sister. He waited till Martha got fed up with all the work and came to HIM to complain about Mary. JESUS knew the answer to Martha's frustration wasn't sending Mary to help her, but rather that Martha would understand HE was the answer. The holiday season is here and with it all the traditions we hold dear. There is nothing wrong with time honored traditions and Martha wasn't doing anything inappropriate. The real problem was that tradition was interfering with Martha's ability to hear what JESUS was saying. Think about it, Martha was in the presence of THE ONLY BEGOTTEN OF THE FATHER. THE KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS, EMMAUNEL - GOD WITH US and all she could think about was a meal! Martha had the greatest intentions but those

intentions were causing her to miss out on the most wonderful experience of her life! JESUS's response to Martha was: And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.(Luke 10:41-42) I am in no way suggesting that we drop our responsibilities to work or family, or to cut out our wonderful Christmas traditions. but I ask; have you chosen that **good part?** When was the last time you sat at the feet of JESUS? Hopefully it's a regular practice because HE desires for you to come to HIM. Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. (Matthew 11:28) The New Living Translation bible puts it like this: But the Lord said to her, "My dear Martha, (put your name here) you are worried and upset over all these
