Moses is in Pharaoh's house, Moses is next in line for the throne but God doesn't leave Moses there. He stirs his heart and moves him out to the people. If God was going to deliver Israel through politics, God would have put Moses on the throne. Now back to Isaiah. Everything that Isaiah put his trust in had to be shaken so God could reveal Himself to the man of God. We live in a time right now that everything that can be shaken will be shaken so that which can not be shaken may remain. Hebrews 12:27 I was reading about the jobless rates in this country and it said that one in five men are unemployed. Many have lost their retirement, their

savings are drained and they can't borrow anymore and they don't know what to do. Because of all the financial stress, couples are divorcing and others are turning to crime to support their families. 
