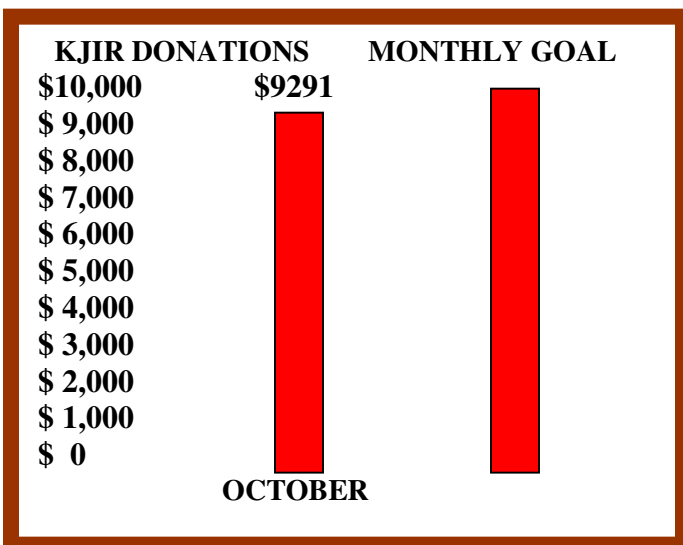
A Taylor, Mo., native, Jayme is the third generation of her family involved in radio.
