Trust – a word that holds victories or failures; it all depends what we have put our trust in. In the book of Psalm 135: 15-18 it says -15) the idols of the heathen are silver and gold, the work of men's hands. 16) They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes have they, but they see not; 17) They have ears, but they hear not; neither is there any breath in their mouths. 18) They that make them are like unto them: so is every one that trusteth in them. As I read these verses the other day, I felt the Lord say to me to take out some money and lay it on my desk. I took out a five-dollar bill and laid it down. When I did that the Spirit of the Lord said this, "Look at the face on that money, it has a mouth and cannot speak, eyes and cannot see, ears and cannot hear and there is no breath in that money. If you put your trust in money you are just like that money and them that make that money. You have eyes and you will not see, ears and cannot hear and a mouth but cannot speak. They that put their trust in money will not have a voice in this generation." To trust is to be confident or sure. After the rapture of the Church, during the tribulation, the anti-Christ will give the mark of the beast and without that mark, they will not be able to buy or sell. Billions will take the mark because their confidence is in money and the world system and not in the true God. They that take the mark will be lost forever. To put our trust in anything

but the Lord Jesus Christ is an abomination to God. We must have a voice to speak to this generation. We can curse the darkness but it is better to turn on a light. Our total confidence must be in the Lord and His Word. I love the verse in Psalm 45:1 – My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things, which I have made touching the king: my tongue is the pen of a ready writer. The King is Christ and the tongue is the power to speak. Many Christian's speak about the Lord but few speak for the Lord. To speak for God is to speak into this lost generation; with the anointing of the Holy Ghost. God knows if you have put your trust in Him and He gives the power to speak. The devil also knows whom you trust in and if you trust in anything but the Almighty. He will know and you will have no power over the enemy.

I want to leave you with the last scripture.

<u>Proverbs 3:5-6</u> – <u>5)</u> Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding, <u>6)</u> In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths. May the Lord keep you and your families in the days to come as you put your *trust in Him*.
