The first part of Malachi 3: 6 says, "For I am the Lord, I change not", also in Hebrews 13:8, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, and today, and for ever". James said, blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love Him. Once a piece of black smelly coal, worth very little, has now very much value because of time, pressure and heat. The wilderness is not for your destruction but to strengthen you in the Lord that you may come to know Him. Jesus Christ never changes. He is the same yesterday, today and for ever. If He has given you a promise, He has not changed His mind. I know I'm talking to some of you by the Spirit of God. God has told you He will save that loved one, husband, wife, maybe that son or daughter. It looks like it will never happen. Too much time has gone by, to much water under the bridge. God has not changed His mind. I change not. The question is, are you going to keep standing on the promise and simply trust in the Lord and put your hand in His unchanging hand? I challenge you to go back to that promise that God gave you and trust God to bring it to pass.
