Unless you like winter here's something good to think about. The Old Farmers Almanac reports that Thursday March 19th is the first day of Spring. It's good to think on the good things, as the scripture says, Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things

honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. (Philippians 4:8) Of course, when Paul wrote these words to the Philippians he wasn't talking about the weather; he was referring to the truth and command of THE GOSPEL. 
and are confronted with hardships everyday, which is why it's so important to have a mind full of GOD. JESUS said,
