Nothing wrong with that but let us consider the wisdom found in the Book of Proverbs. There are many devices in a man's heart; nevertheless, the counsel of the LORD, that shall stand. (Proverbs 19:21) The New Living Translation puts it this way, You can make many plans, but the LORD'S purpose will **prevail.** Our Heavenly Father never called any of us to come up with the perfect plan HE'S already got that, it's called "The Bible". If you know the Bible, you are acquainted with how the great Apostle Paul began. Before being known as Paul he was known as Saul of Tarsus. And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do. (Acts 9:3-6) "It is hard to kick against the pricks" literally means, It's futile to resist Divine Will or

Authority. The phrase is a metaphor that comes from the practice of using a goad to steer an ox while plowing. A goad is a stick with a sharp iron tip that a farmer would use to prod an ox to keep it moving in the right direction. If an ox rebelled by kicking at the goad, it would only drive the goad further into its flesh, causing it more pain. The phrase is a reminder that resisting GOD'S Will is selfdestructive and ultimately harmful. Saul was a quick learner because the first words out of his mouth were, Lord. what wilt thou have me to do? This must be the cry of the Church! Saul obeyed and learned the plan of GOD. Later he became Paul and wrote most of the New Testament which is the plan of GOD. I can open the Bible and know what the future holds. GOD Says, Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, Declaring the end from the beginning, and

from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure: (Isaiah 46:9-10) As we seek to know the Will of GOD in 2025, we can rest assured that the HOLY SPIRIT will never lead us contrary to what is written within the pages of The Bible. If we want to know GOD'S Will for healing, it's in the Bible. If you want to know GOD'S Will for your business, it's in the Bible. If you want to know GOD'S Will for the plan of Salvation and reaching the lost, it's in the Bible. If you want to know GOD'S Will on anything, it's in the Bible.
