How about the first responders who put out fires and assist in medical emergencies, sure it's their job and they do it for a wage but law enforcement, fire fighters, and emergency personnel sacrifice safety to help others. I also think about the sacrifices of all those who have given their lives to spread the GOSPEL Of JESUS CHRIST. We read in Romans chapter 10, For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? 
## upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. (Isaiah 53:5)

Every song, every message on KJIR Radio has the influence of The Gospel. Our sole purpose is to broadcast the Message of JESUS CHRIST through song and word, to edify and be a blessing to the Body of Christ. Each month we send out hundreds of these newsletters to listeners who have given in the past with the hope that we will receive back a gift in the self-addressed envelope provided so that you can partner with us. We try to make it as easy as possible to give. Our goal is \$10,000 a month to pay for building maintenance, tower maintenance, computer maintenance, technology upgrades, expansion, add new employees, salaries, legal fees, etc., etc., and the list goes on. In the past 12 months we average approximately 49 gifts a month, with an average amount of \$2,829.30 received each month. That's the average, some months are more, and some months are less. I have never gone into this much detail before on what we receive, but I feel obligated to share this so that everyone will be aware of the need we have. Like I mentioned before, sometimes we take things for granted and expect that those things will always be there. If we aren't paying the bill, you can be sure somebody else is. With the exception of our transmitter which was replaced in December 2017 with your financial help, we are still using the same technology we used over 20 years ago to operate this full power radio station. We have only two employees to perform many different tasks. KJIR will need to do some upgrading of equipment in the near future and GOD will provide. Next month KJIR will celebrate its 25th anniversary of being on the air and we thank GOD for all of the faithful people HE has used to make this possible. AND WE THANK YOU for being obedient to give. As always remember KJIR stands for KING JESUS IS RETURNING! GOD BLESS YOU!
